Requested By: Dimension in Art

Proposal Description: Purchase of museum quality markers to identify each major art installation housed at SRS

Total Cost: approximately \$630

Requested Amount: \$250 (to supplement the \$500 previously budgeted for art maintenance)

Detailed Proposal with Supporting Information:

Dimensions in Art requests an additional \$250 to supplement the \$500 line item for art maintenance currently budgeted to purchase plastic, printed markers which will provide proper identification for each major art installation at SRS. There are twenty-one (21) pieces at SRS that require markers. The majority of the artworks are 5th grade legacy projects, most of which contain no identifying information like the date of the work, name of the visiting artist, year of the 5th grade class, title, materials or any other identifiable information. The markers identified are plastic and will range in size based on the necessary printed information (facts available) about each artwork, with the average being 5' x 7". Text will be printed as opposed to engraved. The cost of each marker will average \$20-\$30 per 5" x 7" plate, depending on the amount of individual printing required. They are weatherproof, inexpensive, easily replaceable in the event of damage and can be affixed with either glue or screws.

If approved, the \$120 remaining in the art maintenance budget will be earmarked for the purchase of supplies to repair and/or reconstruct parts of broken tile and mortar on several artworks.
